The 21st season of Concerts Under the Stars, one of Fort Lauderdale's most popular music series, marks its thrilling debut on the third week of January at Bonnet House Museum & Gardens. The exciting new season continues with presentations on February 16 by the Florida Grand Opera, followed by Lynn University String Quartet on March 16, and culminates with a performance by the Dillard Center for the Arts Jazz Ensemble on April 6.

The Young Artist Music series, initially conceived as a community outreach program, has become one of Bonnet House's most anticipated, successful and treasured programs. Each evening's activities take place in and around the colorful and fascinating house, one of our nation's most popular historic estates, with the concerts taking place on the veranda, under South Florida's beautiful starry skies. All of the evenings activities begin at 7pm.

Individual tickets for this long-awaited 21st Anniversary Season start at \$35 per performance for members and \$40 per performance for non-members. Accentuating the great value of a musical series that has been called "quite possibly the best entertainment deal in town," the price of admission also includes wine, cookies and coffee for each performance. Bonnet House's membership program includes an annual admission pass, and the estate is also available for exclusive private rental for weddings, parties and special events. The mission of Bonnet House Museum & Gardens is to steward the legacy of the Bartlett and Birch families by preserving their historic estate and providing programming that nurtures creative expression, delights the senses, educates, and honors the natural environment.
