



Bonnet House's Popular Birding Classes Return in August!

FORT LAUDERDALE, F.L., July 25, 2017 - [Bonnet House Museum & Gardens](http://www.bonnethouse.org) is offering birding classes for beginner to skilled bird watchers beginning Sunday, August 20th from 2pm to 5pm on the Bonnet House Estate. A recent survey from the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service reported that one in five Americans has an active interest in bird watching. If you're one of the many who enjoy the infinite beauty and variety of our winged friends in South Florida, the next few months will provide you with a great deal of joy at the beautiful Bonnet House Estate. Our extremely popular Birding Classes return, led by birder extraordinaire Paddy Cunningham, who has been a professional Naturalist in south Florida for over two decades.

All of the classes take place on Sundays from 2pm – 5pm. The first of the individual classes, Ascend to Better Birding I: Tools of the Trade, begins Sunday, August 20, followed by Ascend to Better Birding II: A 10 Step Approach on August 27, continuing with Hawks Galore, September 10 and Richardson Park Field Trip, October 29. In November, we have Shore Birds Made Easier, November 12, followed by Bird Behavior: A Key to Better ID on Sunday, December 10. A repeat of the popular Ascend to Better Birding I, Sunday, January 21 and Ascend to Better Birding II, February 11, Birding by Ear on March 11 and finally Warblers Made Easier on April 8. The cost is \$20 for Bonnet House members, and \$25 for non-members.
